Notes for Elizabeth (Betty) Sunderland

Betty was the daughter of William and Mary Law Sunderland. She died while making the journey from Yorkshire to Liverpool by cargo boat in order to catch a boat to America. She was pregnant at the time (Eva Warburton Proctor). She was buried at sea. John and young son Edward continued on to Utah.

Notes for John (Spouse 1)

John is described by LDS sources variously as being born in Haslingden or Radcliffe, Lancashire on 16th June 1823. However the FamilySearch pilot shows the son of James and Elizabeth of Haslingden was baptised the previous year. Also on the 1851 census his birthplace is given as Haslingden, though his age is a little low for his birth date.

John and Betty joined the Mormon church in Halifax and decided to emigrate to Utah. Unfortunately Betty died at sea (with her unborn child) en route to Liverpool to catch their ship. John and son Edward made the journey alone.
